The World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly is held every four years and defines the next period of study for ITU-T. WTSA-24 is planned to take place from 15 to 24 October 2024 in New Delhi, India.

WTSA-24: Purpose

- Set the **structure and vision** ITU-T for Study Period 2025-2028
- **Express this vision** through a coherent set of **Resolutions and A-series Recommendations**
- In practice, differs from study group meetings:
 - Rules
 - Participants
 - Multiple languages
 - Content / significance

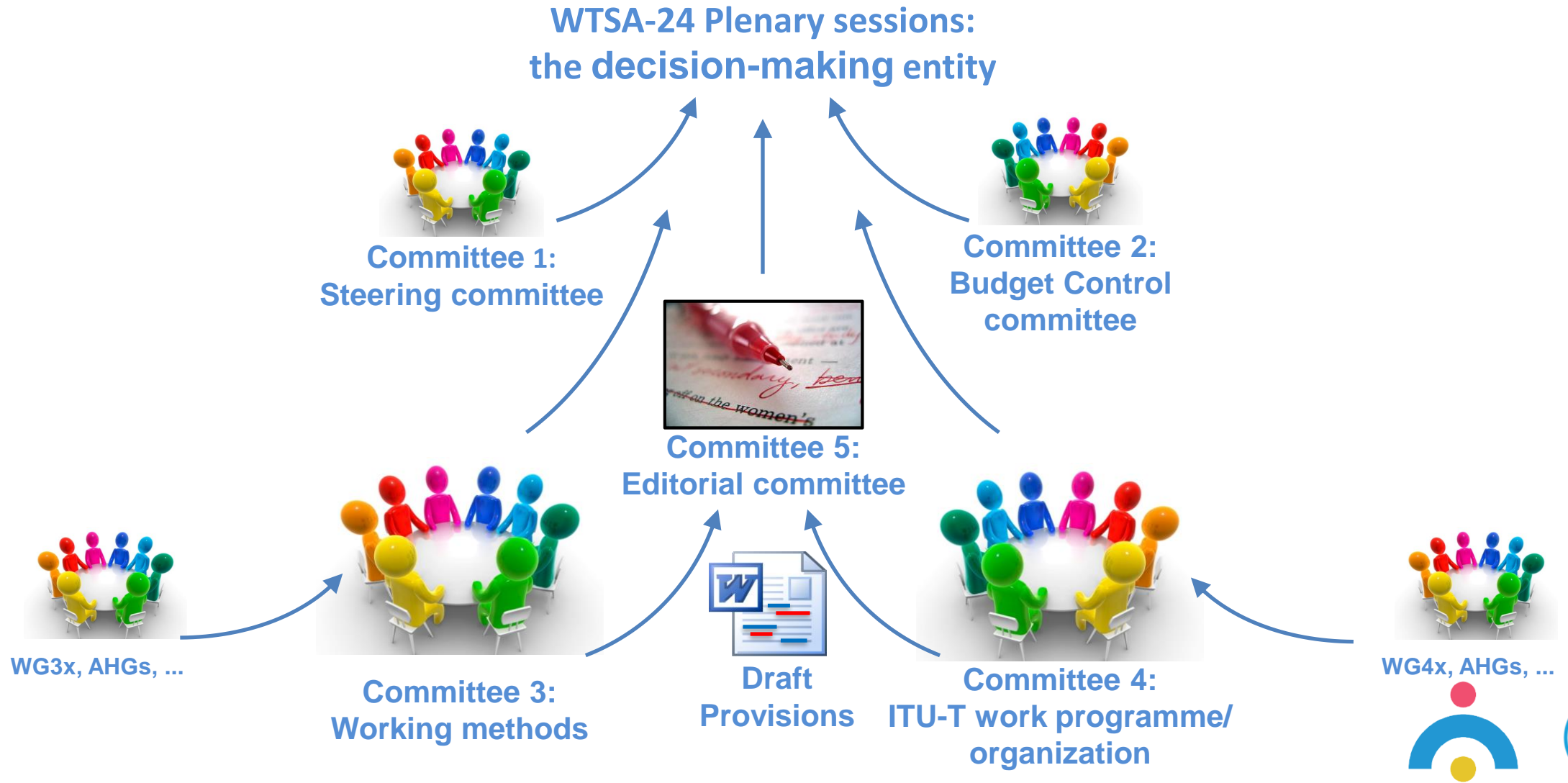

WTSA: High-level workflow



Call to Action to all delegations

1. **Expo:** Showcase innovations from ITU members, spotlighting ITU standards in action.
2. **GSS-24 high-level segment:** Please encourage your Senior Governmental Officials (Ministerial level) & Industry CEOs to participate in the 90min high-level segment (G20 Room).
3. **Gender equality:** Please nominate women to key ITU-T Leadership positions, include women as delegates (35% target), and as heads of delegations.
4. **Youth:** Please include young professionals (up to 35 years old) in your delegation.
5. **Kaleidoscope academic conference:** Please include academia, industry and admin researchers in your delegation.
6. **Side events:** Please leverage the series of side events for networking, information sharing, & collaboration. Access rich content for social media and networking opportunities.

- Submit nominations for TSAG, SG, and SCV Chairs and Vice Chairs by 14 July 2024 (preferred), no later than **16 September 2024**
- Apply for an exhibition booth by **16 August 2024** (preferred), no later than 23 August 2024

Legal framework

1. [ITU General ITU General Rules, Constitution and Convention](#)
2. [WTSA Resolution 1](#) (Rev. Geneva, 2022)
3. Embodied in ITU-T's working methods

Interventions:

1. The session chair gives delegates permission to intervene
2. Consider non-native speakers, captioners and interpreters:
 - Speak slowly and distinctly
 - Interventions normally start with “Thank you chair, I am speaking as [role or affiliation]”...
 - ...and end with “This concludes my intervention.”

Decision-making in ITU-T

1. Consensus-building ensures win-win decisions
2. Avoid voting (limited to Member States)
3. Soft decisions (Consent, Determination, Agreement, etc.)
 - Nevertheless, some decisions are quantifiable (e.g. 70% affirmation of Member State consultation, etc.)
4. Approval processes:
 - a) Traditional Approval Process (**TAP**): Policy or regulatory standards
 - b) Alternative Approval Process (**AAP**): Technical standards
 - c) World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly (**WTSA**): Sensitive or difficult standards
 - d) Study group **Agreement** of other (non-normative) texts
5. The General Rules (**GR**) of ITU apply



What is consensus?

The term “consensus” has multiple meanings, including:

- Unanimity, unopposed agreement, etc.
- Absence of sustained opposition (ISO/IEC)
- Substantial agreement (ANSI)
- In the end, in ITU, it is the Chair’s judgement

Keep in mind:

- *Consensus is a **process** where the chair of a meeting accommodates the different views, which culminates with the chair concluding that there is **general agreement** for adopting a decision **without a vote and without formal opposition**.*



Your role as a Leader

1. Keep the end in mind
2. Be fair and impartial, and be seen to be so
3. Listen with care, be sensitive to language and culture
4. Understand the issues in advance of discussions
5. Engage actively, be sociable, available and responsive
6. Give everyone the chance to talk
7. Know when & how to close debate
8. Consult with your TSB Counsellor/Advisor
9. Thank all contributors, including captioners/interpreters
